

RESULTS OF FULTON COUNTY GOVERNMENT SERVICES SURVEY

September 28, 2008

Many thanks to the citizens of Fulton County who responded to the Fulton County Government Services Survey that was recently distributed. Results of the survey are shown below.

- 1) **Grady Health System** - Should we demand that the Grady Health System require residency and citizenship verification? Yes – 83%, No – 17%
- 2) **Balanced Budgets** - Should we require that Fulton County balance its annual budgets without dipping into reserve funds? Yes – 95%, No – 5%
- 3) **Water Needs?** Should we work with other jurisdictions on securing additional water capacity? Yes – 95%, No – 5%
- 4) **MARTA Expansion** - Would you like to see the MARTA Board expand the north line up GA 400 to Windward Parkway? Yes - 78%, No – 22%
- 5) **Courthouse Security** - Do you feel that enough has been done to secure the Fulton County Courthouse? Yes – 60%, No – 40%
- 6) **Capital Spending** - Do you think that Fulton County should budget for building renovations and capital planning through a multi-year capital fund? Yes – 93%, No – 7%
- 7) **Audits** - Should Fulton County audit each of its departments on a regular basis? Yes – 100%, No – 0%
- 8) **Commission Members** - Should the Fulton County Commissioners be elected via staggered terms? Yes – 94%, No – 6%
- 9) **Customer Service** - Should Fulton County provide a one-stop customer service center above the river in North Fulton? Yes – 89%, No – 11%

Your responses and comments are very important to me. As we begin the preparation of the 2009 Fulton County budgets, and look to the Georgia General Assembly for legislative initiatives in the 2009 session, your guidance will help me craft policies and programs that reflect the wishes of my constituents.
